The event offers a unique knowledge and technology transfer center, thanks to the more than 180 international experts who will participate in conferences held within the framework of ChemPlastExpo: the Congress of Applied Chemistry and Industry 4.0, the largest national congress for the chemical sector, and the European Congress of Plastic Engineering. Both will tackle verticals for the automotive, pharma, cosmetic, agrochemical, construction, food, packaging or electronic sectors, in more than 170 speeches organized by José Garcia Reverter, director of the Program of the Congress of Applied Chemistry and Industry 4.0 and the European Congress of Plastic Engineering.
